BIBLE READING CHALLENGE!

Every year we give Bibles to our 3rd Grade children. When we do that we meet with our children and their parents to help them find their way around in the Bible and how to use some of the great features that are provided in our Children's "Adventure Bible."

A year ago, as I was meeting with our class I provided a "Reading trail" for the New Testament that they could color in each time a chapter is read. I decided to do this too! As I started reading, I realized that so much of the way I read is just a paragraph here... a chapter there... a verse or two that relate to another... so I get all around the Bible... but it has been a LONG time since I just read... just start at the beginning of the book and finish it!

I have learned how to read the Bible all over again. And I am finding that as I have gone from one verse to the next, there is an amazing flow through God's Word.

MIGHT I SUGGEST... If you read 3.25 chapters a day you can read the whole Bible in a year. IF you don't think you have 10 minutes a day... take 1 chapter... and give it some thought... look for words or phrases that are repeated... look for your favorite topic and how that might be fed by God's Word.

So... 1189 chapters in the Bible. Some are long... some are short... but ALL of them are God's Word.

I started in Genesis again... just yesterday I read Genesis 18. Abraham and Sarah could hardly get over the idea that this 100 year old man and his 90 year old wife were going to have a baby. As you read that... take a moment to laugh... I highlighted verse 13 and 14, and spent some time on the question raised there, "Is anything too hard for the Lord?" You can highlight some things too!

I was also reading in 2 Kings, chapter 10. I noticed that the house of Baal after it was destroyed was made into a latrine. REALLY? I laughed again.

We can read the Bible to learn... to refresh our spirits... to puzzle over mysteries that are eternal. We read God's Word to meet our Creator, our Savior, our Guide. We can read God's Word to pray, many of the Psalms are ideal for prayer. We often use Psalms in prayer during our worship services.

God's Word helps us learn more about God AND as we read we learn more about our relationships with other people.

If you are looking for a New Year's Resolution... Pick up your Bible. If you don't have one... I can find one for you. Just say the word!

We also provide numerous Bible Studies so you can try a group out... give a call... give it a try.

ZION SERMON CHRISTMAS EVE 2015

John 1:1-14 In the very beginning when the whole world was in chaos and darkness – God created light. The light brought order and life. The world grew and formed and God created people. The people were in God's image - wise, loving and caring. And God said it was all very good. But people could make choices. Sometimes people followed God and love abounded. Sometimes people wanted to become God, and human selfishness took over. The world became dark and people turned inward with cruelty and hatred instead of love. God was not happy. People were not happy. The whole world was not happy. Sometimes the world and the people were far from God.

So God made the creating Word into a human child, sent by the Holy Spirit to be born of Mary. Now God's love, forgiveness, and hope were present in a new way! Tonight we remember and celebrate Jesus, the Christ, born in Bethlehem. God's light of love in our midst! God being present in our broken world! God present in our lives of faith. Love, reconciliation, and hope abounded.

This birth happened in the time of a Augustus and Quirinius. Mary and Joseph led the way. The messengers of God came to people and declared, "To you this day ... a Savior is born!" The shepherds became the first to experience this new light, to bow before the Son of God, and to go and tell the story. It changed their lives. It was the good news! The light and love of God in human form. Emmanuel - God with us changed people and our world!

So now in this time, Christmas 2015, bring your darkness, bring your brokenness, bring your Sin, bring your doubts and fears. Bring your hopes and your dreams. God has entered in. Be re-joyed, renewed, renamed. Be once again, and now, children of God. Today, and tomorrow, and forever! The darkness cannot put out the light in which you now live! For we now behold - the creating light to form us anew each day. To love and serve God. To love and serve one another!

Ponder these things as Mary did it. It makes all the difference! To you and to all of God's people! Go tell it on the mountain!
