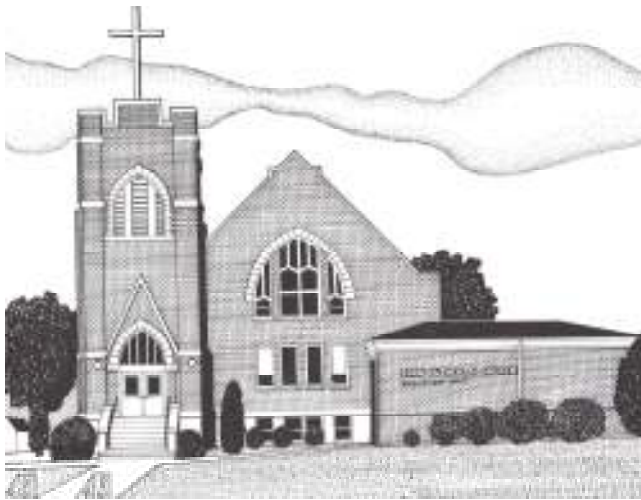

## FROM PASTOR KEITH

In Luke 11 Jesus gives his disciples the “shorter version” of the Lord’s Prayer. This leads into a parable about open and closed doors.

As I was working on this text for the sermon given on July 24<sup>th</sup>, I thought of Alexander Graham Bell’s quote, “When one door closes another one opens.”

I am having that closing door kind of feeling now... and I feel some anxiety with that. Still... I know... that we, at Zion, are so blessed in so many ways!

Again we say farewell to some Zion Staff. These are people who have faithfully used their God-given talents to serve and be a blessing to our church and the communities in which we live. God’s Word shines through these servants.

SARAH DODGE – Sarah IS a teacher. When she was hired here 10 ½ years ago as Ministry Coordinator, we had no idea how her work here would evolve. She has worked to coordinate serving opportunities for many people here through worship, education and Fellowship. Where Sarah’s truest talent shines through is in her love of teaching children. Her article in this Newsletter tells us of her new position as a Kindergarten teacher in the B-W School District. While I am so happy for this open door for her, I am sad that her role here is completed. Through her ability to write curriculum for Zion’s ZAP summer program AND our Sunday School, we have found a new way of education and reaching out to our community. ZAP and Zion Sunday School have become great Outreach programs welcoming children and families into our faith community.

VICTORIA LOVESTRAND – Vicky is retiring as Sr. Choir Director here at Zion. We have a wonderful choir here, and Vicky’s leadership has done more than teach songs. Vicky knows how to teach SINGING! Singing comes from the heart and reaches the hearts of those who hear it. Vicky’s ability to reach the heart of the singers has created an open loving community of musicians. Their love for music and their love for one another shines through their time together as they share that love and their faith with us in song. Vicky has brought together other talents with drummers and strings and brass and bells and piano and organ and the many people who make those instruments sing.

As we offer our heart-felt gratitude for their sharing of their gifts, we are blessed. I am grieving these changes, but if I can practice what I preach, then I will let go of my anxiety about closed doors and pray that God will show us the open doors that are now before us. I still wonder... is there 1 open door... or 15... or 100 open doors? I want to remain open to God’s guiding and trust that as much as I want things to stay the same... it will not. Change can be scary, but faith tells me that God knows what to do.

May we all share our words of gratitude with Sarah and Vicky and with all our musicians and teachers and leaders and parents and supportive members, knowing that as we come together, looking to Christ, the new things will be a blessing to us. Our Council will open up this conversation this month and I am sure they will want input from Congregation members. Blessings to us all as these doors close and as other doors open to us... may we look to God.
