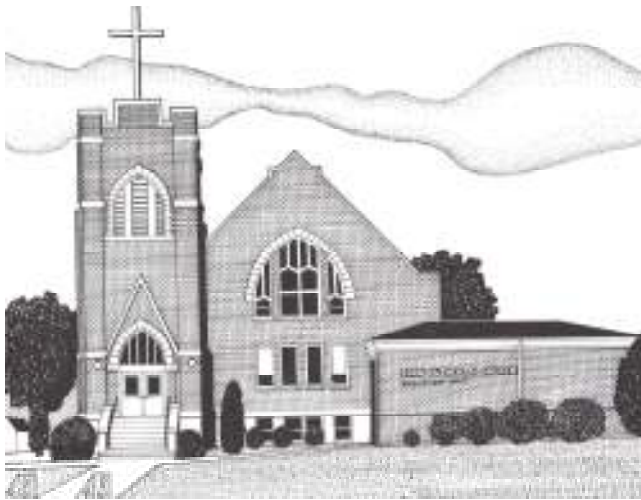

FROM PASTOR KEITH

I like stability! I like being comfortable! I like the people I work with and when there are changes I don't like the feeling of uncertainty.

Over the past couple of years we have had a LOT of changes in our Church's staffing. Our previous custodians, Matt and Michelle have moved out of the area or taken on other jobs, and Michael is going back to school. BUT... I continue to learn that God will provide and so I am grateful that David Leon and Elizabeth Leon have taken on the Custodial responsibilities of the church. I am also grateful that John and Rachel Terkelsen have been so willing to step back into a supportive Custodial roll and re-enter where they had served before retiring 3 years ago.

We have had a change in our Choir as well! Victoria Lovestrand retired as Sr. Choir director. With her leadership we saw our choir grow and rejoiced in a culture of fellowship that bound that group of people together. We enjoyed a wide variety of choral pieces, some of which were enhanced by other musicians and instruments including violin, cello, timpani, drums, flute, brass, bells, and more. Again, my heart sank... and as I am not typically a worrier... I did feel some worry creeping into the corners of my heart and mind. BUT... I continue to learn that God will provide and so I am grateful that Elizabeth Leon has taken on the position of Sr. Choir Director. Thanks also to Susan Randall for coming to the rescue, once again, as Choir Accompanist.

AND... Our Ministry Coordinator, Sarah Dodge, after 10 years in that position, left her job here to accept a position as Kindergarten teacher in the Baldwin-Woodville Schools. Sarah is a teacher... it is not just what she DOES... it is WHO SHE IS! As Zion's Ministry Coordinator, her job changed somewhat over the years and a large part of what she did for us was TEACH! She created the curriculum for our Summer ZAP program AND created every aspect of our Rotation Style Sunday School Curriculum. Even days before she left this position at Zion she was putting the final touches on the Sunday School Curriculum for this entire Sunday School year. This buys us some time, but the Council is once again looking at this as an opening. Jill Boston is taking on the responsibilities of Volunteer Coordinator and the on-line Newsletter posting. Even now we are looking at next year's Sunday School needs. Can we find someone to write Curriculum OR will we go back to purchasing. I hope that I will remember and continue to learn that God does provide for our needs.

I have seen the strong and steady and providing hand of God countless times over the years... still... I need to learn that lesson of faith over and over and over again. I think one of the things I like about stability is that I like the predictability of things going on as they have always gone on... but the lesson of faith might also show me the predictability of God's faithfulness... even in times of personal change.

Perhaps I will learn again, that this church is not mine... it is not ours... it is not made up of predictable positions of responsibility... THIS CHURCH IS GOD'S CHURCH!
