## FROM PASTOR KEITH

"Happy New Year!"

When someone says, that... I take it as a wish... not a command! If I could command people to have a happy new year I would... but the fact of the matter is that over the course of a year, some NOT happy things occur.

"HAPPY!", speaks to me of some kind of joy. I can feel happiness, but what can I do to create happiness? That could be a challenge for this new year... to consider how I DO happiness in this world. I find that many times BEING happy, comes from SHARING good things with others.

"NEW!", speaks to me of something that has never been done before. There are times when the unknown can be rather un-nerving. The NEW thing... how will it go? What will it be like? How will a NEW thing affect all the old and comfortable things in my life? We can continue asking questions about the new thing... but, the fact of the matter is that, we don't know what we don't know. It is NEW...

"YEAR!", speaks to me of an extended period of time. 365 days, usually. While a year can go by very quickly, there are times that a year can feel like it drags on and on and on... For the child who is already looking forward to NEXT Christmas... a year is a long way away. To a person who is dealing with an extended illness... a year is a long way away. When you make a year-long commitment... you are in it for the long haul.

As we think of a new year coming, some think of that new year as a year of great possibilities. Others look at it in a more negative way. For some, the possibilities of the NEW YEAR are exciting, while others dread the thought of it.

Why does one person have a "Happy New Year," while the next person says, "Bah Humbug!"?

I wonder at times how FAITH affects our outlook of the future. I would NOT say that if you are a Christian, everything is going to go well. We all have our times of struggle and sadness, so happiness is not guaranteed to every Christian, all the time. BUT... I am convinced that there is something of a deeper nature that satisfies the believer's soul, no matter the emotions of the moment.

The Apostle Peter spoke of this deeper place of joy that comes through faith. This joy is NOT dependant on the feelings of the moment. "Though you have NOT seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him NOW, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy."

The Bible's definition of "FAITH" is found in Hebrews 11:1, "Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do NOT see."

So... "Happy New Year" is somewhat a statement of FAITH! We have not seen the future, but we can rejoice and have hope, because Jesus said He would love to be a part of it.

The better part of what we do NOT know and what we do NOT see... is Jesus.

Now... this is not a command... but my wish for us all... that we could all be more intentional about inviting Jesus into our New Year, and into all of our unknown moments and find the greatest joy in a renewed relationship with Him. I do believe that His presence in our daily lives will create a deeper joy than we can put into words.

Blessings to us all as we make more room for him in our lives.
