500 years ago Pastor Martin Luther of Wittenberg Germany got it! He felt guilty and inadequate, and thought that he was a lost sinner living before and angry and judgemental God! For there is no distinction; since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, they are justified by God's grace as a gift, through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus ..."
