FROM PASTOR KEITH

So much is going to be happening soon. It is important that we put on our WELCOMING HAT! I don't know what that hat is really... but we are a church that welcomes all into our fellowship... and some people who will be coming here, or returning, have little "church-life" experience.

The WELCOMING HAT, could be the hat you wear when you greet someone you have never met before.

This may happen in church... it may happen in the Fellowship Hall.

OF COURSE, our hope is that many will be here for Sunday School and will touch base with each other and with God through our Family CONNECT or other worship services. But they may meet YOU!

So... consider... how important it is to be welcomed, especially if this is a new place or if people have not been here in a while. That word of welcoming friendship may make the difference between new people becoming regular worshipers in this family of faith... OR... never seeing them in church again.

Welcoming the stranger is an important part of God's Word... here are some samplers...

- **Deuteronomy 10: 19** You shall also love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- **Leviticus 19:34** The alien who resides with you shall be to you as the citizen among you; you shall love the alien as yourself, for you were aliens in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God.
- **Matthew 25:40** Truly I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of my brethren you did it to me.
- **Romans 13:8** Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.
- **Romans 13:10** Love does no wrong to a neighbor, therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.
- **Acts 10:34** Then Peter began to speak to them: "I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him.
- **3 John 5** Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do for the friends, even though they are strangers to you; they have testified to your love before the church. You do well to send them on in a manner worthy of God; for they began their journey for the sake of Christ, accepting no support from non-believers. Therefore we ought to support such people, so that they may become co-workers with the truth.
- **Hebrews 13: 1** Let mutual love continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it.

We don't think of neighbors we do not know as "aliens", but we could think of this as "the unfamiliar one"... and then, as the host, we extend a welcome so that we can know one another better. These welcoming actions also help draw people into a more enriching life of faith.

I am sure we would all agree that it is important to share our faith with our families... the extended family now includes people we stand in line with as we enter the Fellowship Hall... or people we meet after 9:00 worship as the 10:15 crowd gathers.

We have MANY opportunities to share a good word with someone we might not know. That welcome draws others to God.

So... practice... in the next few weeks or months... practice... a word... "it's good to see you today!" OR... "I am so glad to see your children here... how old are they?", etc. I don't need to give you the line by line... we all know how to greet someone new... the challenge now... is to do it!

Put on the WELCOMING HAT... and... if you don't wear any kind of hat during church... then open up a welcoming heart!
