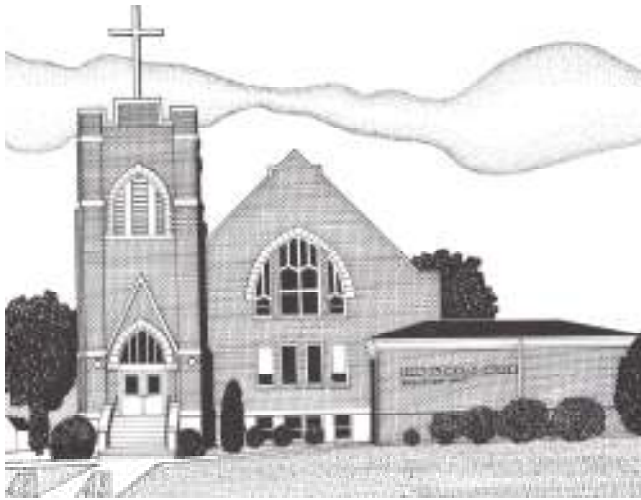

MISCELLANEOUS...

SUMMER PREACHING AND MUSIC - This summer, Pastor Andy and I will be taking a break from the "revised Common Lectionary" (our regular rotation of Bible readings... to see that lectionary you can look in the front of the hymnal pages 18-63.)

We are asking for YOUR favorite Bible Stories, Bible verses, and hymns / songs. We will get our heads together and work out the preaching schedule, but you need to be here to catch them! Although, we will share with you all requests in our June / July Newsletter. We are looking forward to this.

CHILD PROTECTION – We are evaluating our church insurance policies. We have a Child Protection policy in place, but we realize we could do so much more. We did an on-line evaluation last year and some suggestions were put in place for us for follow-up. We have learned that churches have MORE insurance claims regarding child abuse / mistreatment, sexual abuse / misconduct, than any other kind of claim. Our Church council is looking into policies that can be implemented quickly. Our Fellowship Committee ("FUN = Fellowship Uniting Neighbors) is looking into a Family First series for this coming Fall. Our Zion's Women's group is going to be sharing with us a directive from the Synod Women's Organization regarding Human Trafficking (prostitution, kidnapping, etc.)

BUILDING UPDATE – With a 100 year old building there are ALWAYS things to maintain. Thanks to John Jamieson and Boy Scout Troop 110, the area in the Bell tower basement that was damp and crumbling is being repaired and refurbished. We have done MANY exterior repairs, including raingutter repairs and heat-tape (to stop winter ice-dams), we are hoping to get some ideas about interior repairs to the sanctuary walls. We have not looked into those repairs yet, because we need to make sure exterior repairs are taken care of first.

BIBLE READING / STUDY – God's Word is essential to the life of a Christian. Each Christian should be reading this Word. Every week we gather for worship and that is when most people hear the Word of God. That is a good start to spiritual maturity, but only a beginning. MANY OTHER opportunities are provided here at Zion.
