

FROM PASTOR ANDY BOE

Following are some thoughts on the Sunday Bible Texts for Syttende Mai Weekend (May 19, 2019) in Woodville. I think the three "Visions" presented in these Bible Verses are important for use as we move forward in our Christ inspired mission here at Zion - "To Serve the Lord, To Care for All, and to Spread His Word!"

The First is John's Vision recorded in Revelation 21 - God's dwelling place is in the midst of God's People - God Incarnate. This is given to us as God's Gift in our Baptism, the "water of life." We are now, and forever, the Children of God! Nothing in body, mind, or spirit can ever take this gift of God's Grace from us!

The Second is Peter's Vision recorded in Acts 11 - The message of Good News and Freedom in the Gospel is for every creature in all of God's creation! We are to be "Inclusive" in our understanding that everyone with whom we make contact is a participant in all of God's gifts! The community of faith has one mission - to share the Good News with all people!

The Third is Jesus' Vision recorded at the Last Supper in John 13 - Jesus says the "New Commandment" I give to you is "Love one another." Jesus' self-giving, and serving all Love, is special. The new part of this love is that now it is God's Love which is given to all in the example of Jesus, who we know as the Risen Christ. Jesus' love reaches out to touch and include all!

The issue I see for us as Members of Christ's church is this: We want to, and do, say - "Yes Lord!" However in our practical application of Jesus' loving and serving all - Saints and Sinners! - We tend to say "Yes! Lord! - BUT!" We understand what Jesus is asking, BUT surely it can't be for everyone?! So I labeled this Sunday of Syttende Mai - "Yes, Lord! - BUT - UFF DA!" God's love is wonderful and meant for all, but it is really hard for us to follow completely the example of Jesus in our own lives, individually, or as a congregation at Zion.

My prayer for us is this. God help us to be strong and supportive of one another, listening to your Word, and making what you say to us practical in our daily lives! God help us to change and transform the "BUT - UFF DA!" to your LOVE, FORGIVENESS, AND HOPE FOR ALL! shown by our daily example!
